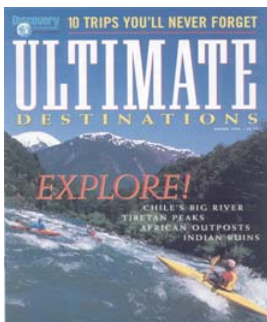

Here, Olympic paddler Chris Spelius has created an international DESTINATION for fly fishing, kayaking, and rafting. Additional adventure activities you may include on your trip are mountain biking, horseback riding, canyoning, hiking, sea kayaking and sit on top kayaking. Your experience level may change from none to the most experienced, depending on the trip you choose.

The lodge is set amidst the crystalline, turquoise waters of the abundant rivers and lakes that flow into the Rio Futaleufú, the "Crown Jewel of South America".
